

## Estimated Annual Financial Requirements for International Students For Certificate or Associate's Degree: 2023-2024

## **Tuition and College Fees**

Estimated Billable Tuition and College Fees (per academic year)= \$14,190.24<sup>1</sup>

## Living Costs

Average living costs for a 9 -month academic year include the following expenses: personal items and clothing, room and board, transportation<sup>2</sup>, books and supplies<sup>3</sup>.

Total *estimated* living costs for one academic year (without dependents) = \$22,470.00<sup>4</sup>

- Students are required to show an additional \$4,830.00 per dependent<sup>5</sup>
- If living locally with family, deduct \$8,800 from living expenses

Total Estimated Costs = \$36,660.24

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Tuition is for 12 - 18 credits for each of the fall and spring semesters. Summer school tuition is not included. Fees include mandatory college and activity fees along with mandatory international student accident and illness insurance.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> This only includes local transportation. Travel to and from your home country and the costs of owning a car, are additional expenses.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> The exact amount needed for books and supplies will vary based upon your academic program and the individual courses that you are enrolled in each semester.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> This is a modest, "no extras" budget. It is highly recommended that you bring at least 10% more.
