**TITLE:** DISPOSAL OF REFRIGERANT ACID TEST KITS

**Regulatory Citation:** 6 NYCRR Part 373-1.1(d)(1)(iii)(c)(2) and 6 NYCRR Part 372.2(c)(8)(iii)(d), 373-1.1(d)(1)(iii)(c)(2)

**Applicability:** Acid test kits

**Purpose:** Proper storage of hazardous waste in satellite accumulation area.

**Person or  
Department Responsible:** HRS Lab Technician

**Schedule:** As needed.

**Procedures:** When acid test kits become waste, the Lab Technician will place them in the five-gallon pail label, "Hazardous waste, acid test kits" and secure the cover on the pail. When the pail is full, the Lab Technician will contact the Director of Environmental Health & Safety to have the pail transferred to the hazardous waste storage shed.

The Director of EHS will ensure the pail is labeled and an approved waste hauler removes the container within the 180 day storage period. The hazardous waste manifests will be signed by a designated staff member and kept in the EHS Department files.
