Touch Panel Features

Recording:

To start recording, touch Record and touch Start recording.



An automated voice will indiacte that the conference is recording.

To stop recording, touch Record and touch Stop recording



An automated voice will indicate that the recording has stopped

To turn PIP on/off, touch camera icon and touch the checkbox next to Selfview Selfview To move PIP, press and hold selfview icon for two seconds until it turns blue, then move PIP to any gray box HVCC Test Space

Using AirMedia on Windows

Open a web browser and type in the IP address shown on screen When loaded, hit Start Presenting



If the App is already installed, wait for it to open. If the App is now downloaded, hit the Windows box to start



The download will start and show up on the bottom of the screen. When done, Click on it



Once the App opens, a box will appear in the middle of the screen



Once the App is fully loaded, type in the code that appears on the screen, hit OK
