



High School Equivalency (TASC) Preparation Course

Eligibility

To enroll in the TASC Program a student must take a pre-admission test. Only those who are currently performing at an 8th grade level can enroll in the TASC course. Exceptions to this will be limited and made on a case by case basis with the recommendation of the instructor. Please contact our office at 518-629-7339 to register in one of these sessions.

If you are enrolling in this class and are under 19 years of age, there are very specific guidelines that need to be met before you can sit for the exam. Please visit the New York State website- <http://www.acces.nysed.gov/ged/> and carefully review the Application and Eligibility Requirements.
